In the Spring of 2023 Still I Rise carefully reviewed the use of the Future Classroom within Nairobi International School. We collected student and teacher reports on their experiences with common classrooms as well as the Future classroom. We also collected observations of the functional use of the two types of classrooms from outside observers.




Intentional Design

How would you rate the design of your classroom?




Design impacting learning experience

Comfortable Creative Space




Students report they feel more comfortable in the Future Classroom.



5 KEY ASPECTS OF OUR FUTURE CLASSROOM DESIGN





Flexible and Adaptive Seating

The classroom includes seating that is comfortable and moveable to suit the learning of the day. It can be adjusted for group work or direct instruction.



Collaborative Areas

To enhance student-centered approaches, there are spaces for collaboration and group discussion which fosters a deeper understanding of topics.



Technology Integration

The classroom incorporates technology and leverages resources in order to create immersive learning experiences.



Enhanced Comfort

Students feel comfortable, safe, and connected in this environment. They can become more open-minded, curious, and connected to their learning.



Facilitating Innovation

Teachers have increased opportunity to facilitate project-based learning, flipped instruction, and creative student-centered activities within the space.
